The Calaveras County will continue the 2008 election year with the 2nd free screening of the acclaimed health care crisis documentary SiCKO by Michael Moore. A facilitated forum will follow, giving participants opportunity to voice their opinions on challenges and solutions affecting the level of health care service and delivery in Calaveras County. Everyone is welcome.

The San Andreas screening is set for Monday, February 11 at 6:00 pm at Oak Shadows Mobile Home Park Clubhouse located at 1330 Calaveritas Road, San Andreas.

The Valley Springs screening will be Saturday, March 8 at 1:00 pm at the Rancho Calaveras Community Clubhouse at the corner of Hwy 26 and Baldwin Ln., Valley Springs.

The series will continue with screenings in Mokelumne Hill, Westpoint, Arnold, and Copperopolis. Dates and times will be announced shortly. Donations are welcome and popcorn and beverages will be served. Proceeds will benefit the M.A.C.T Health Board, operating multiple health care facilities in the four counties of Mariposa, Amador, Calaveras, and Tuolumne.
